LEARN Campbell Campus School Hours

School hours are as follows:

- Scholars are in class between 8:25 am and 4:00 pm. Instruction begins at 8:25 am. Scholars arriving after 8:25 am are considered tardy.
- No scholar is permitted to enter the building before 8:00 am. Please note that there is no adult supervision outside the building before 8:00 am. LEARN is not responsible if anything happens prior to 8:00 am.
- Scholars may enter the building at 8:00 am for breakfast. Breakfast is served from 8:00 am to 8:20 am.
- Dismissal begins with kindergarten around 3:50 pm and continues until 4:00 pm with the dismissal of 4th and 5th grades. After 4:15 pm any scholars not picked up are considered late pick-ups. At 4:10 pm, scholars who are not picked up will return to the second floor, LEARN Campbell Campus and parents must come into the school to pick their scholar up. There will be a charge of \$1.00 per minute that you are late picking up your scholars.
- Office Hours: 7:30 4:30 (Office will close from 3:30 4:15 for dismissal)

LEARN Campbell Campus VISITATION POLICY

All visitors must check in with the Marillac front desk, identify themselves with identification and state the reason for their visit. The front desk receptionist will contact LEARN to announce the visitor. After LEARN has been contacted, visitors will be allowed to take the stairs to LEARN Campbell Campus, located on the second floor. Visitors are required to follow LEARN'S visitation policy which is included in the main section of the handbook.

If you wish to meet with an instructor, administrator or visit your scholar's classroom, please schedule an appointment in advance. Please call 773-826-0370 to request an appointment. Appointments with instructors and classroom visits may be arranged by contacting the instructor directly by telephone, email, or written note (which can be given to your child or left at the main office).

ALL uniforms should be NEAT and CLEAN each day. We will strictly enforce our uniform policy this year. This will also be a part of our Class Dojo point system. Scholars will receive a detention after 3 uniform violations. It is important that parent check Class Dojo daily for uniform updates. Scholars are only allowed to wear colored gym shoes on their gym day. They must also wear a LEARN Gym uniform. No LEARN gear will be allowed on gym days. This will also be a part of the gym grade this school year.

Parents should encourage their child to maintain acceptable standards of good grooming and cleanliness and show concern for his/her appearance and hygiene.

Students are not permitted to change into or out of uniform in the building unless a written request is received from the legal guardian of the student stating the purpose or the scholar receives permission from his/her instructor or principal.

Boys

- ***Sweatshirts_with hoodies and jackets are not permitted.

Girls

- LEARN polo shirt

- *During cold months, if scholars find the need to wear a sweater it must be <u>solid burgundy</u>, <u>black</u>, <u>navy blue</u> <u>sweaters or sweater vests</u>.
- **If you want to wear a thermal or long undershirt, you must wear solid burgundy, black, navy blue to be worn under your shirts.
- ***Sweatshirts with hoodies and jackets are not permitted.
