Isolation

Policy for SY22-23 as of 8/3/22

Following a positive test result for COVID, students and staff (regardless of vaccination status) will be required to isolate for a minimum of 5 days before returning to work/school.

Please note: Staff and students are required to return to the masking guidelines at each campus once quarantine requirements have been fulfilled.

Partially vaccinated is currently defined as not completing all required doses of the primary vaccination series.
